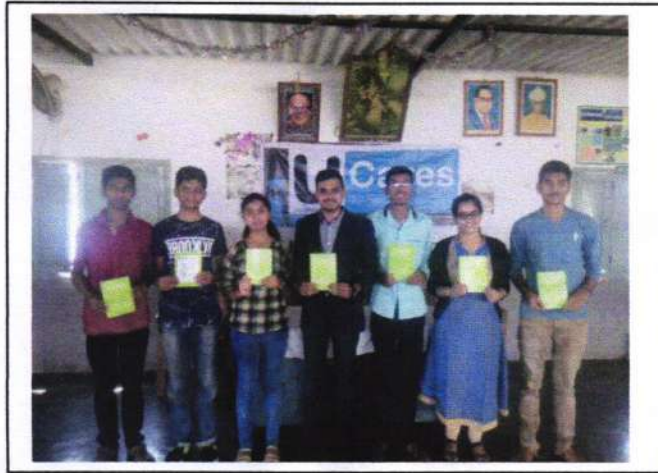

NSS ANNUAL CAMP 2017 – 2018

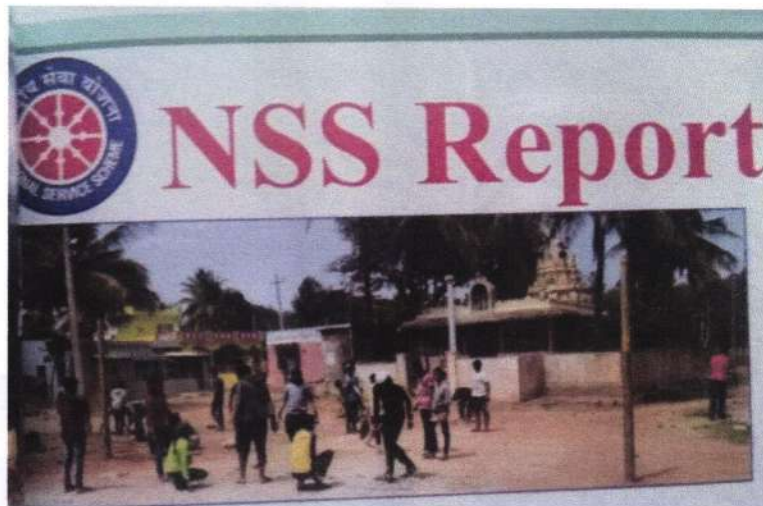
16.02.2018 to 22.02.2018

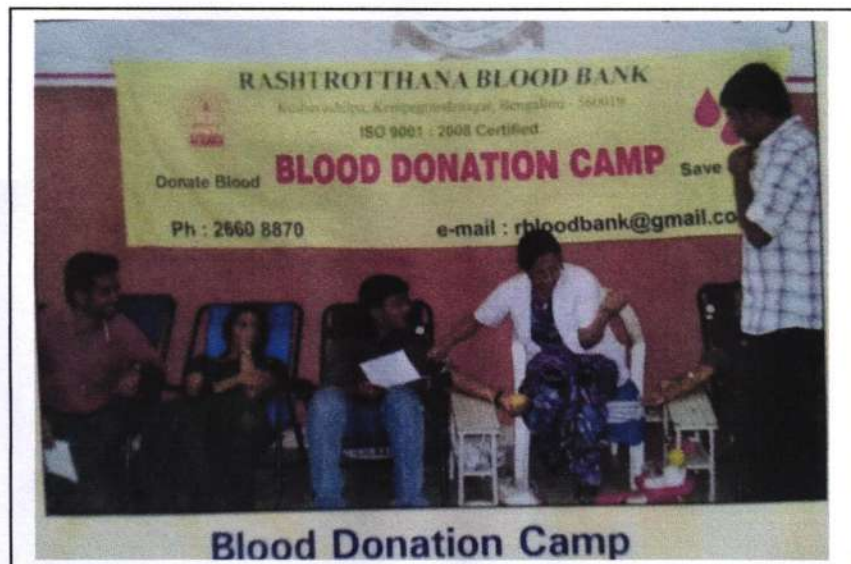

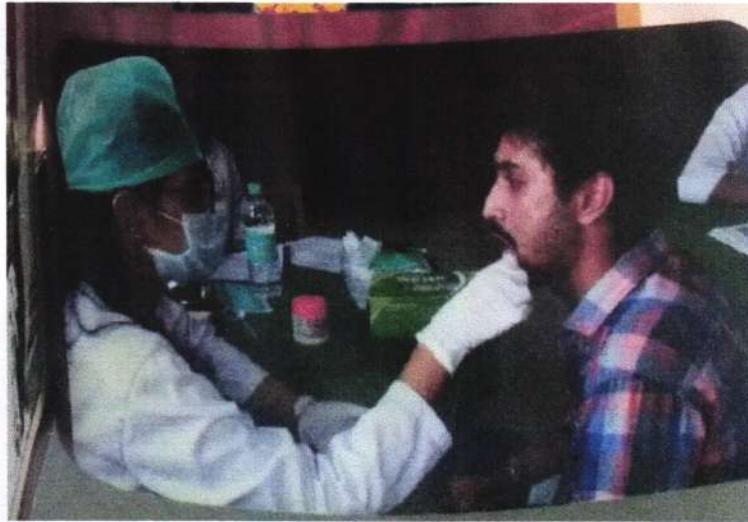
