

Memorandum of Understanding On Exchange of Faculty

Between

This Memorandum of Understanding is effective from 04/09/2017to establish collaboration by and between MES Institute of Management, Rajajinagar, Bangalore and Sri Sai College for Women, Rajajinagar, Bangalore, for the purpose of Exchange of Faculty.

Preamble: Whereas, MESIOM and Sai College for Women have many areas of common interest in Commerce Education, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the field of academics. Therefore, MESIOM and Sai College for Women have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), which defines the framework for the collaboration of the two institutions in the following aspects:

- 1. The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of both the institutions

Validity: The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of 3 years.

Amendments/Modifications: This MOU may be amended or modified by a written

agreement signed by the representatives of both the Institutions.


