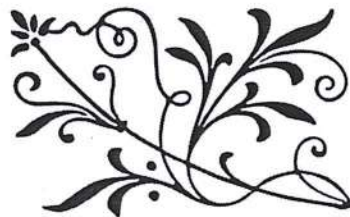

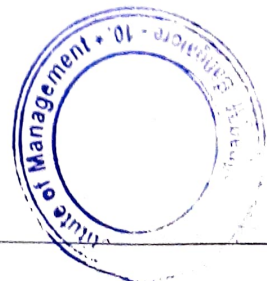

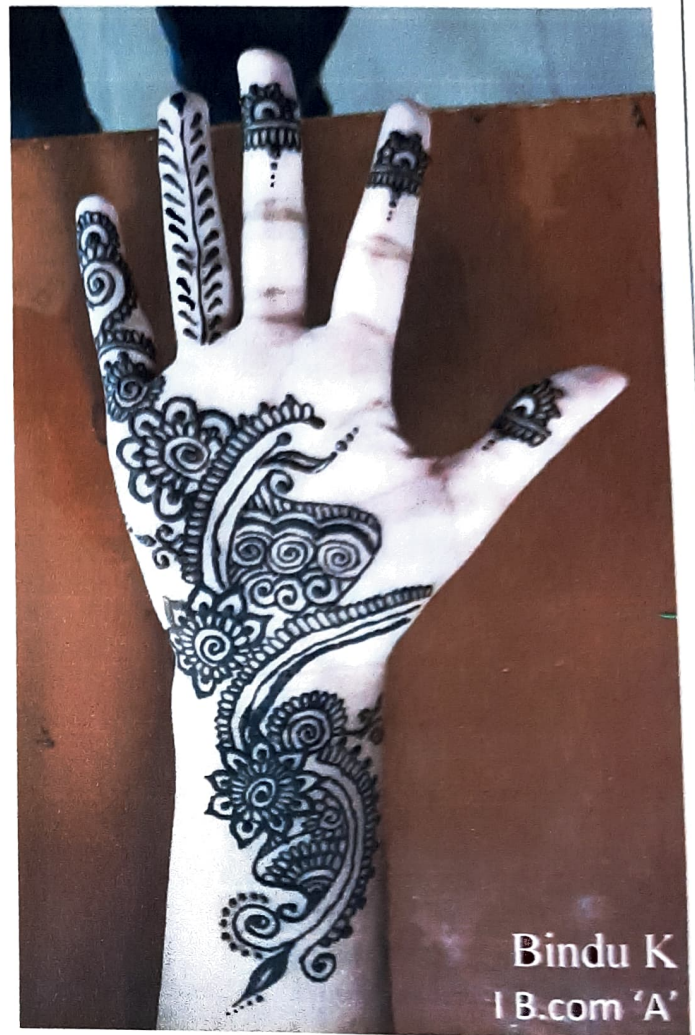

AN ORIENTATION ON HYDROPONICS

DATE: 25-02-2021

Hydroponics is a technique of indoor farming inducing plant growth, making the process 50 percent faster than growth in soil. This method is free from harmful chemicals and pesticides and also it is cost-effective. It increases man power.

Objectives:

- To educate students about the entrepreneurial opportunities in field of hydroponics
- To create awareness among students about growing plants in nutrient solution with limited capital and limited space and built their own business.
- To acquaint students with the knowledge as to how urban farming can be converted into a business.



In line with this, EDP Cell of MESIOM had initiated this program on 22nd February 2021 at 11:00 AM. A total of 50 students from I Year B.com & BBA had attended this program. The Guest Speaker for the session was **Mrs. Ann Winya Thomas**, CEO of Heaven On Earth. We also had **Mr. Arun kumar**, adding insights to the session.



The session involved a brief introduction to Urban Farming, followed by the methods of growing plants without soil, instead with using mineral nutrient solutions in a water solvent.

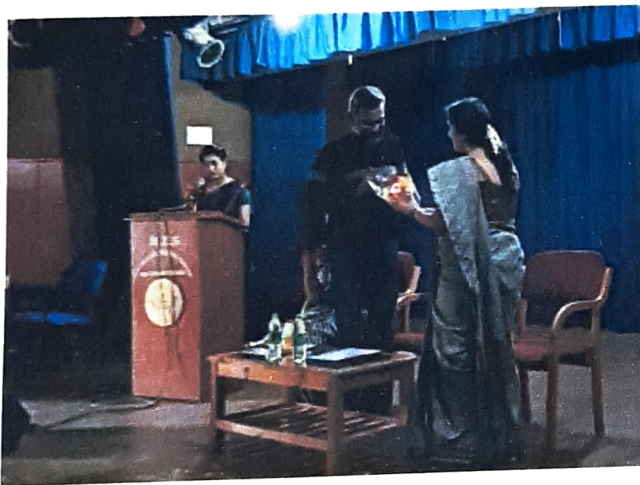
