Library Report

Introduction:

The library of MES Institute of Management is an integral element of the teaching and learning process and it is designed thoughtfully to meet the academic needs of the students and faculty. Vast collection of reference books and textbooks help the students and faculty members to explore, gain knowledge and further their research work. It has a rich collection of academic resources with 10,455 books along with several magazines, newspapers, journals, e-resources, back volumes, CDs, project reports and question banks of both Bengaluru University and Bengaluru City University.

- Internet facility is made available in the library for staff and students. Apart from the desktops available for browsing. Any student/staff with personal laptop can connect to the internet services in the library.
- A Library committee is formed and it consists of five members including the Principal as the Chairman, the Librarian as the Co-ordinator and three other members from departments. The committee meets at regular intervals and deliberates on purchase of books & journals, subscribing of e-resources, augmentation of library facilities and infrastructure.
- Library Orientation Programme is conducted at the beginning of every academic year to help the in-coming students to familiarize with the library facilities.
- There are separate sections/corners for displaying the, 'New Arrival' and displaying of Journal and Magazines. A pin-up board is set up in the library to display special articles from daily newspapers / Journals
- Library e- resources like INFLIBNET- N list, National Digital Library (NDL), and Karnataka Digital Public Library (KDPL) are made available through obtaining membership from the respective Service providing centres, making access to knowledge quick and at one's finger tips.

2015-2016

1. In 2015 - 16 – Easylib Software was installed and the books were also bar coded.
2. A self financed 'Book Bank' facility was started in the academic year 2015-16 and it allows Library to issue textbooks, specifically, to students belonging to SC/ST category.
3. A special reading section was created for faculty members inside the library in the academic year 2015-16. This section can be used for referring books, reading newspapers, magazines and journals.
4. Text Books and Reference Books purchased:
Over the past year in addition to maintaining and improving the existing library infrastructure, MESIOM has added 263 Titles, 782 volumes and 10 journals.

Library Day Celebrations 2018-19

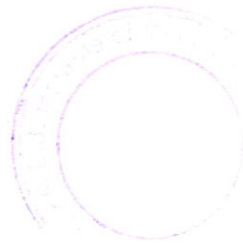
