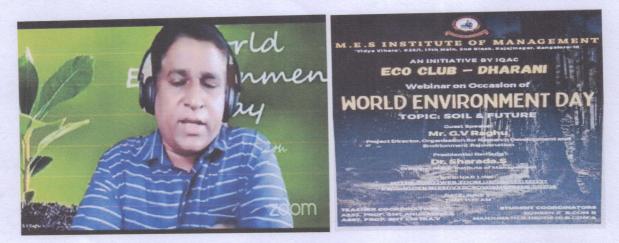

Report on International Yoga Day

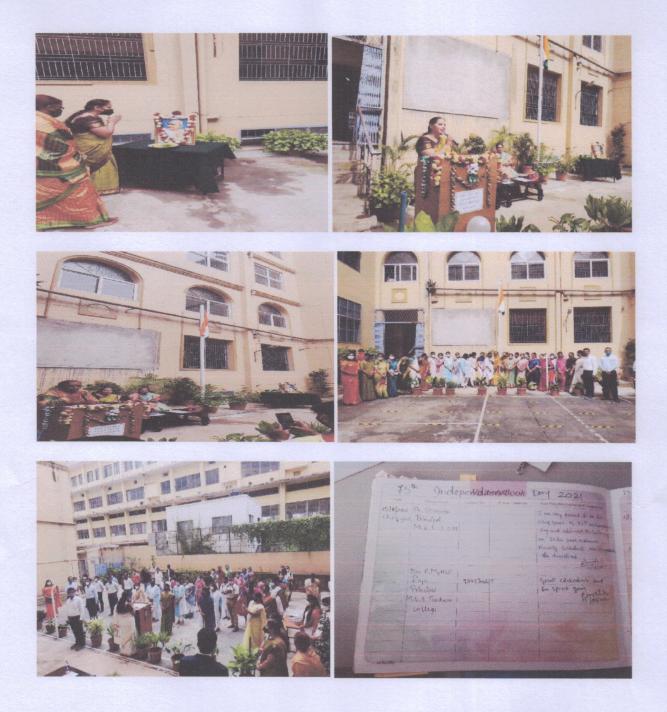

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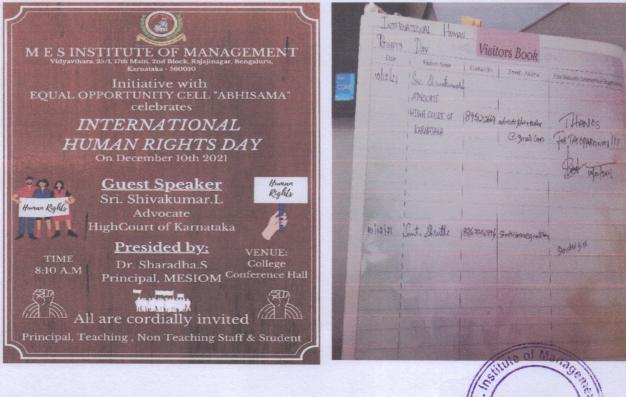

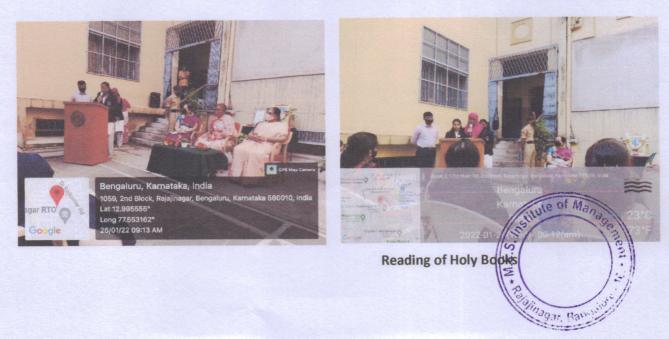


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Report on Republic Day

She has had a brilliant academic career, securing 22 gold medals, 52 publications, 105 research papers (32 international), delivered 210 scientific lectures and has authored "Step by Step to ECHO in CHD" and edited monogram on "A RF & amp; RHD". She has proposed the Echo criteria for the early and precise diagnosis of carditis in Acute Rheumatic fever and National Policy for Congenital Heart Disease. She has received the Best presentation award for "My nightmare case" at PICS at Chicago and in Boston, first prize for

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Outstanding Scientific Presentation at World Congress of Echocardiography and has received many prestigious awards for her academic and literary work.

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The Principal, teaching faculty, office staff and students of MES Institute of management had supported immensely to conduct the event and make it successful.







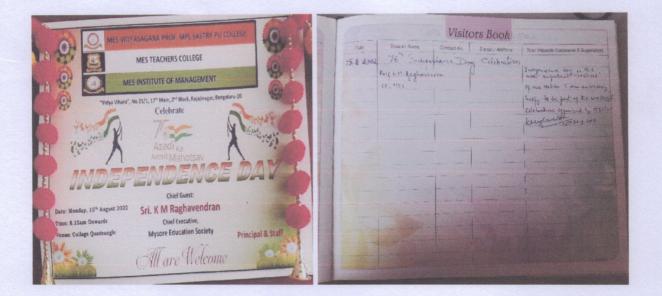
