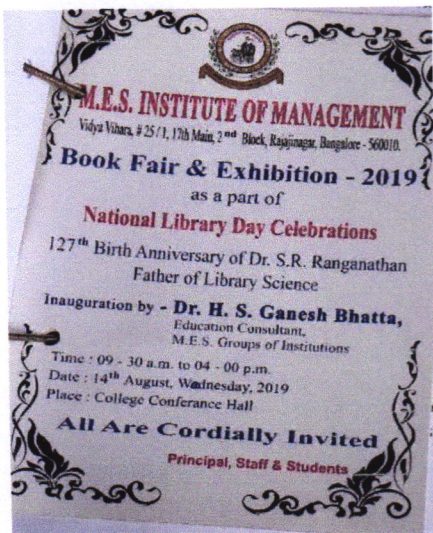
Annual report of the celebrations and commemorative events- 2019-20
