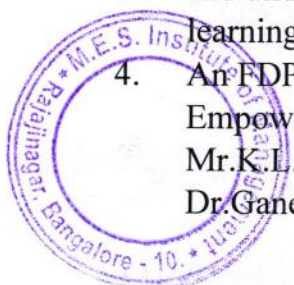

ACTIVITIES REPORT 2015-16

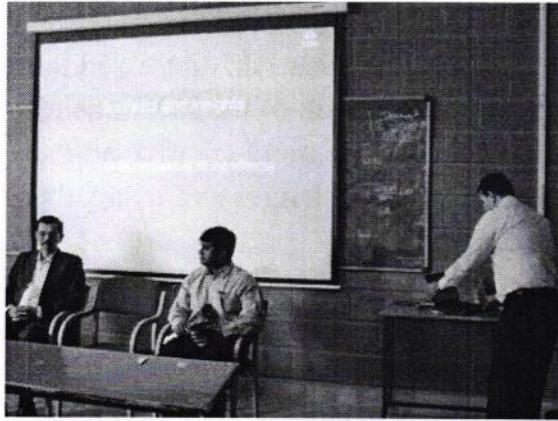
