
The Equal Opportunity Cell of MESIOM conducted a seminar on Fundamental Rights with Special Reference to Equal Opportunities for first B. Com and BBA students on 23/1/2015. The Resource Person was Smt.Shashirekha, Adv, High Court, Karnataka. Addressing the students, she referred to Article 14 & Article 15 of Indian constitution, right to equality, which is one of the fundamental rights and ensures to every person the right of equality before the law and equal protection of law. She also mentioned that no one is above law and all are equal in the eye of the law. She gave examples of Air India v/s Nargesh Meera Regulation and DS Nakara v/s Union of India cases to help students understand the ambit of equal opportunities.

Speaker also emphasized article 15, 15(3), 15(4 and. Article 15 which declares no discrimination on grounds of place of birth, gender, caste and religion and special consideration given to women and children in article 15(3) and she also referred the consideration for ST/SC/OBC in article 15(4). Article 14 ensures equal rights without discrimination and Article 15 gives equal status to citizens belonging to different races, religion, social status or wealth. Right to equality is one of most important part of our constitution which gives strength to all those people to secure their right for the better living.

- Seek remedy in case of violations.
