**REPORT OF GENDER SENSITIZATION PROGRAMME – 2018-19**

**TITLE OF THE PROGRAM: SEMINAR ON HUMAN RIGHTS.**

**RESOURCE PERSON: SRI L. SHIVA KUMAR BCOM., LLB ADVOCATE**

The equal opportunity cell conducted a Seminar on Human rights for Ist sem B.com and BBA students on 29.9.2018. The Resource Person Sri.L. Shivakumar, Advocate, addressed the students about Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) and quoted 'Recognition of the inherent dignity and of the equal and inalienable rights of all members of the human family is the foundation of freedom, justice and peace in the world' - Preamble of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. UDHR (Universal Declaration on Human Rights) consists of Preamble and 30 articles. These 30 Articles are further divided into 4 categories: General Articles (1 and 2), Civil and Political Rights (3 to 21), Economic, Social, Cultural Rights (22 to 28), Concluding Provisions (29 and 30). He opined that article are the symbols of human rights and fundamental freedom. These rights give the opportunity to human beings to live with dignity and to increase the standard of living. Their aim is to provide social security, adequate food and basic fundamental rights.

Sir said that the world's longest written constitution, the Indian Constitution which was adopted on 26th of January 1950, has a great impact on provisions of UDHR. The Fundamental rights, Directive Principles of State Policy, Preamble of Indian Constitution have a close similarity with the context of UDHR in the forms of Articles. Indian Constitution generally preserves the values set down in the UDHR provisions. Fundamental rights and directive principles of state policy were discussed after 10th December 1948, the day on which UDHR was adopted. This clearly shows the impact and influences of the Indian Constitution on UDHR. Indian Constitution covers the aspects of human rights, so does UDHR.

**Outcome:**

- Students got thorough knowledge about UDHR and how it has been reflected in PART III and PART IV of our Constitution.
