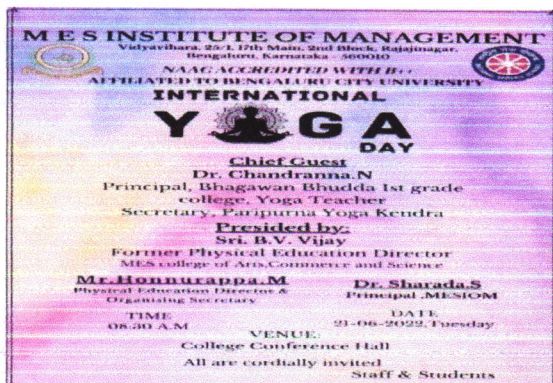
Report on Environment Day

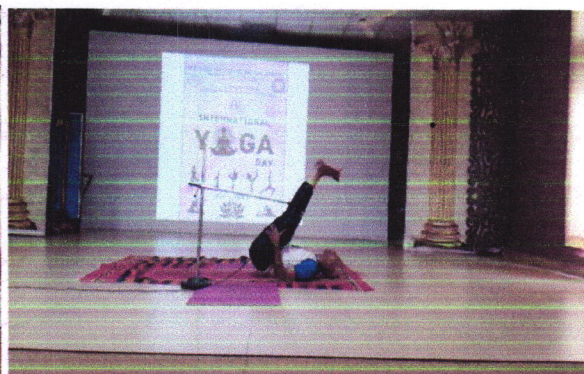


International Yoga Day

Report on Kargil Diwas

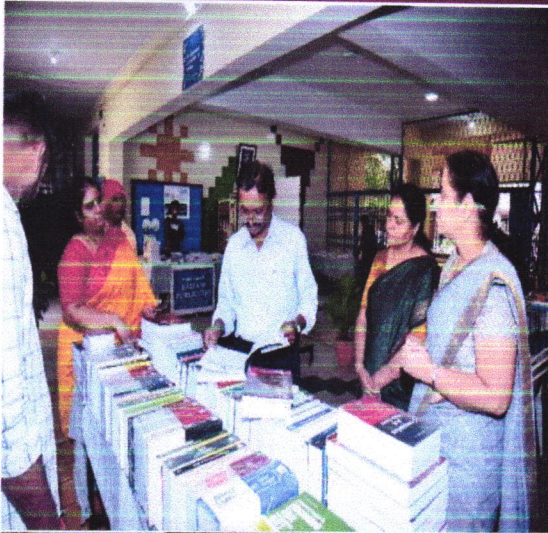

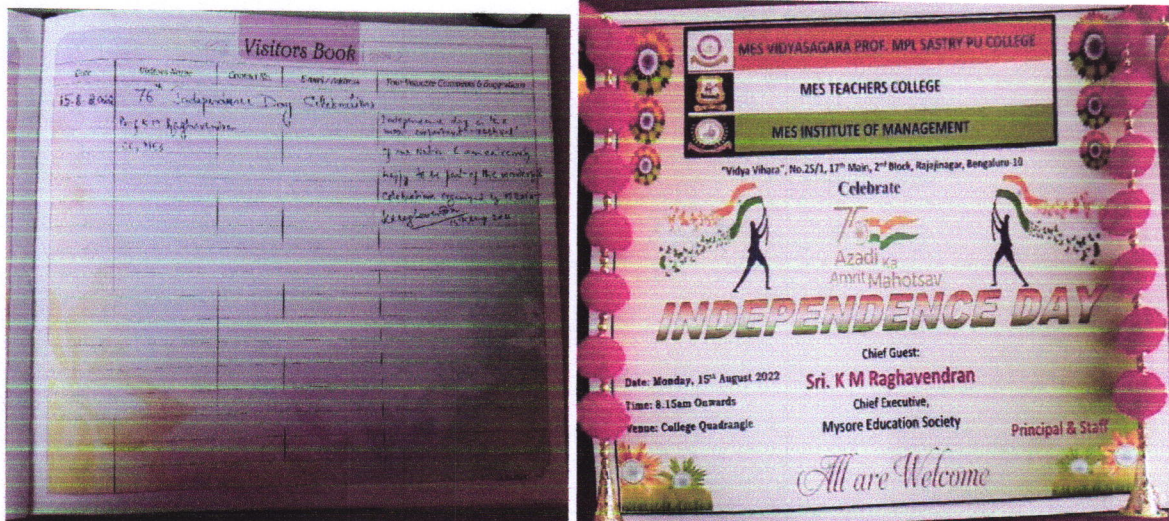

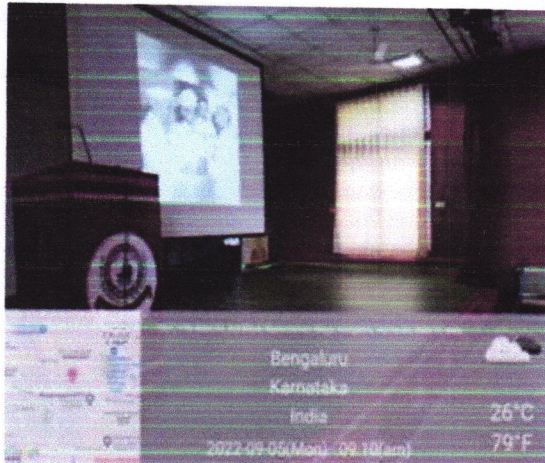

Report of Teachers Day

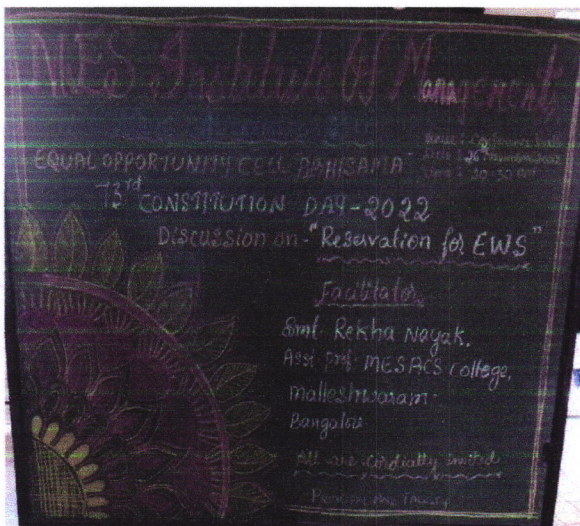

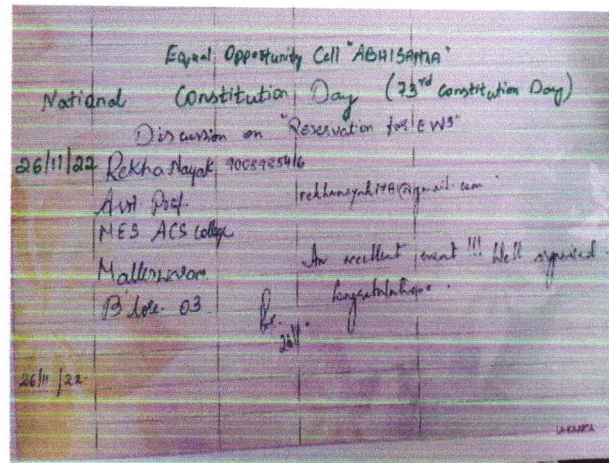
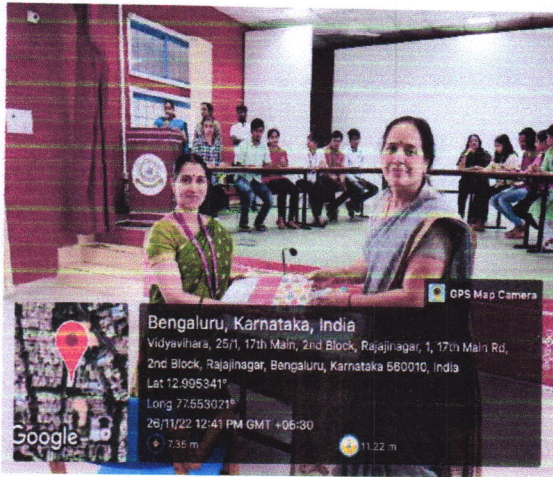




Report of Constitution Day

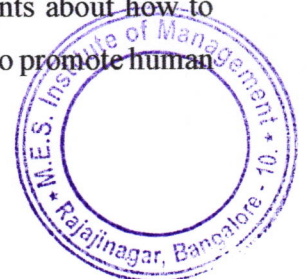

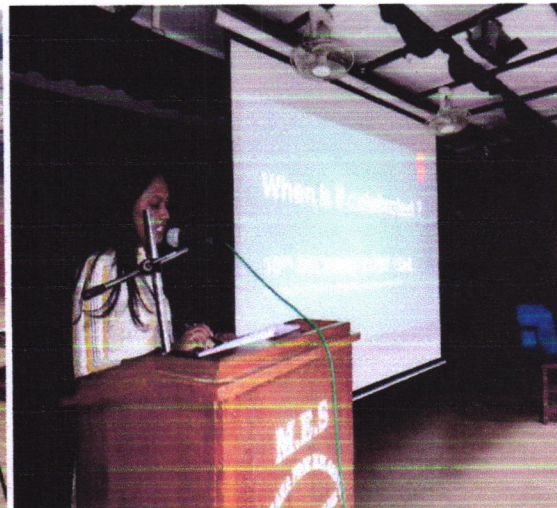
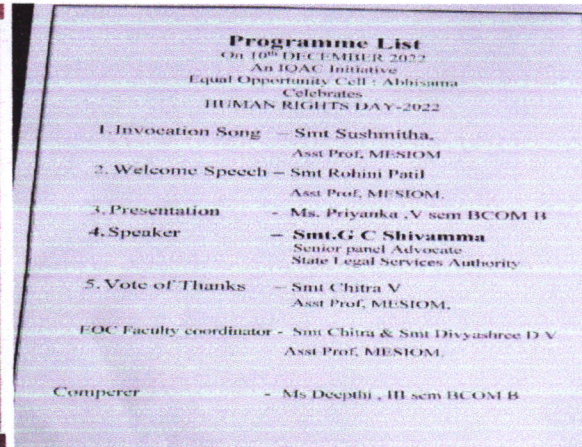
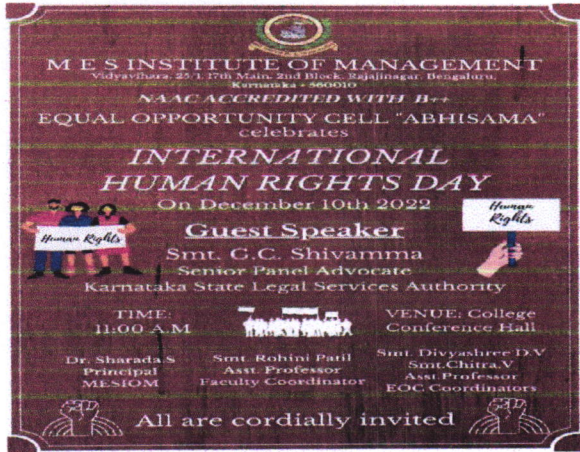


International Human Rights Day

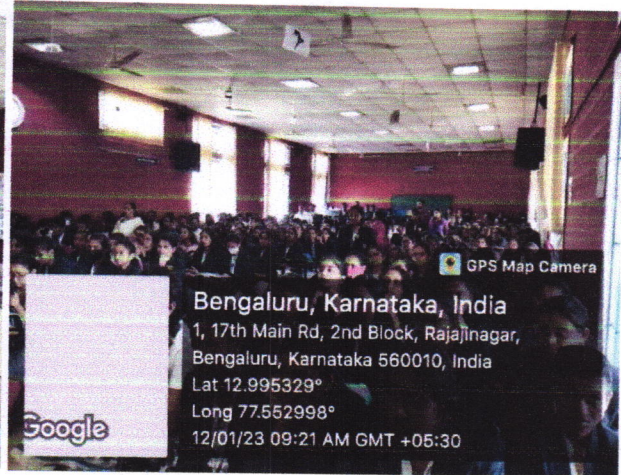


Report On National Youth Day

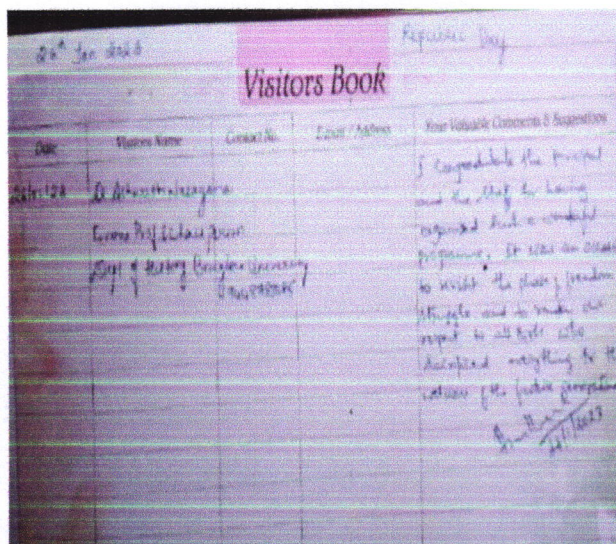
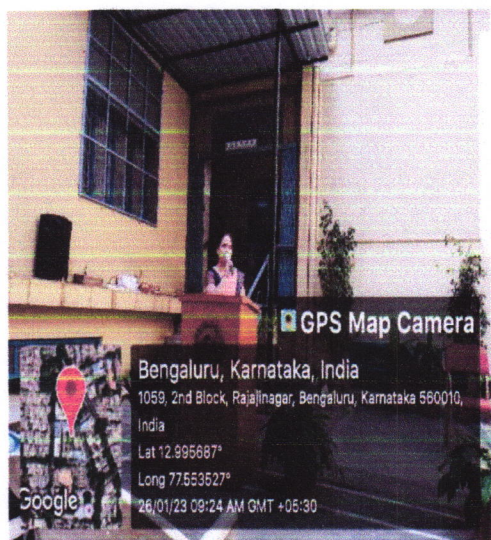
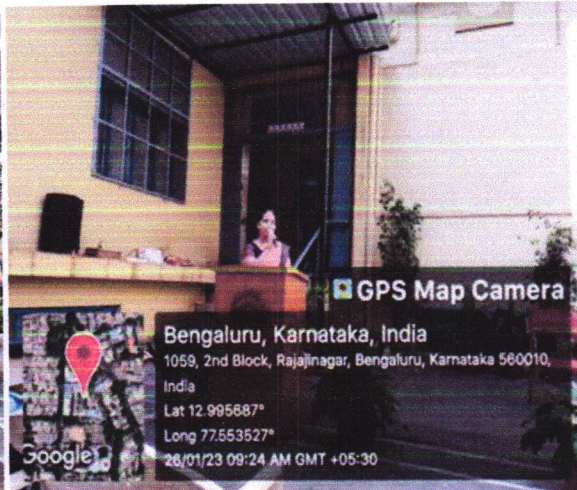




Report on Republic Day
