

7.1.6 Beyond the campus environmental promotion activities

On October 15th 2023, our college students in association with Social Spotlight Club organized a lake clean-up drive at Agara Lake. The event dedicated efforts to cleaning the area surrounding the lake. Their hard work contributed to the success of the event. The initiative aimed to raise awareness about environmental conservation and the importance of maintaining clean water bodies. Participants were equipped with cleaning tools and safety gears to ensure efficient and safe clean-up process. The students collected a significant amount of waste, including plastic, glass, and other non-biodegradable materials.
